- Obtain from management a report listing all sales and purchases of carbon offset credits (in metric tonnes) during the year ended March 31, 2009 (“Carbon Offset Credits Purchases and Sales Reports” or the “Report”) and note whether the total number of carbon offset credits purchased exceeds the total number of carbon offset credits sold during the year ended March 31, 2009 as reflected in the report.
- From the population (as listed on the Report) of carbon offset credits purchased during the year ended March 31, 2009, compare all purchases to a corresponding supplier invoice or purchase contract in order to note any exceptions relating to the number of carbon offset credits purchased.
- From the population (as listed on the Report) of carbon offset credits sold during the year ended March 31, 2009, compare all sales transactions to a corresponding sales invoice or sales contract in order to note any exceptions relating to the number of carbon offset credits sold.

Results of our procedures

- We obtained from management the Carbon Offset Credits Purchases and Sales Reports and noted that the total number of carbon offset credits purchased exceeded the total number of carbon offset credits sold during the year ended March 31, 2009.
- From the population (as listed on the Report) of carbon offset credits purchased during the year ended March 31, 2009, we compared all purchases to a corresponding supplier invoice or purchase contract to note any exceptions relating to the number of carbon offset credits purchased. No exceptions were noted.
